Rules:

1. The Tournament runs from **9:00 to 11:00 AM Saturday September 13, 2008 on the Charlestown Wharf.**
2. This is a catch and release tournament. Handling the fish requires speed and care not to harm the fish.
3. The length of the fish, regardless of species, will determine the winners.
4. The child must be of the age category they enter.
5. Adults may help with rigging, baiting, casting and removing hooked fish.
6. The child must reel in the fish. Adults can help if the child should drop the rod and hand it back to the child, but the fish will not count if the child receives assistance reeling it in.
7. Each fish caught must be brought to the Judges table as quickly as possible to be measured and have the child's picture taken with their fish, and finally release it unharmed.
8. The decision of the judges is final. Prizes will be awarded for the first 3 places in each age group courtesy of the **MARINER** magazine.
